

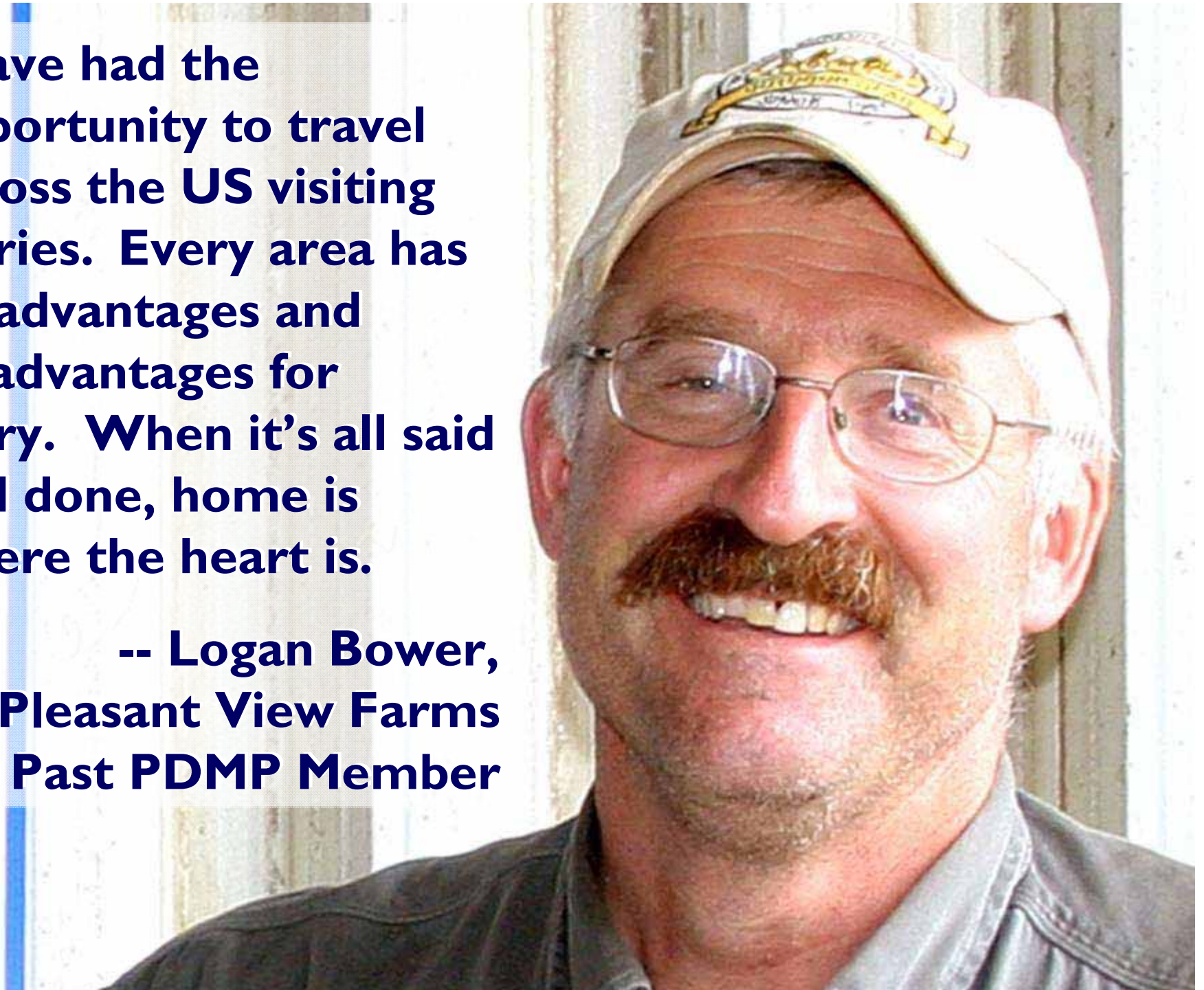

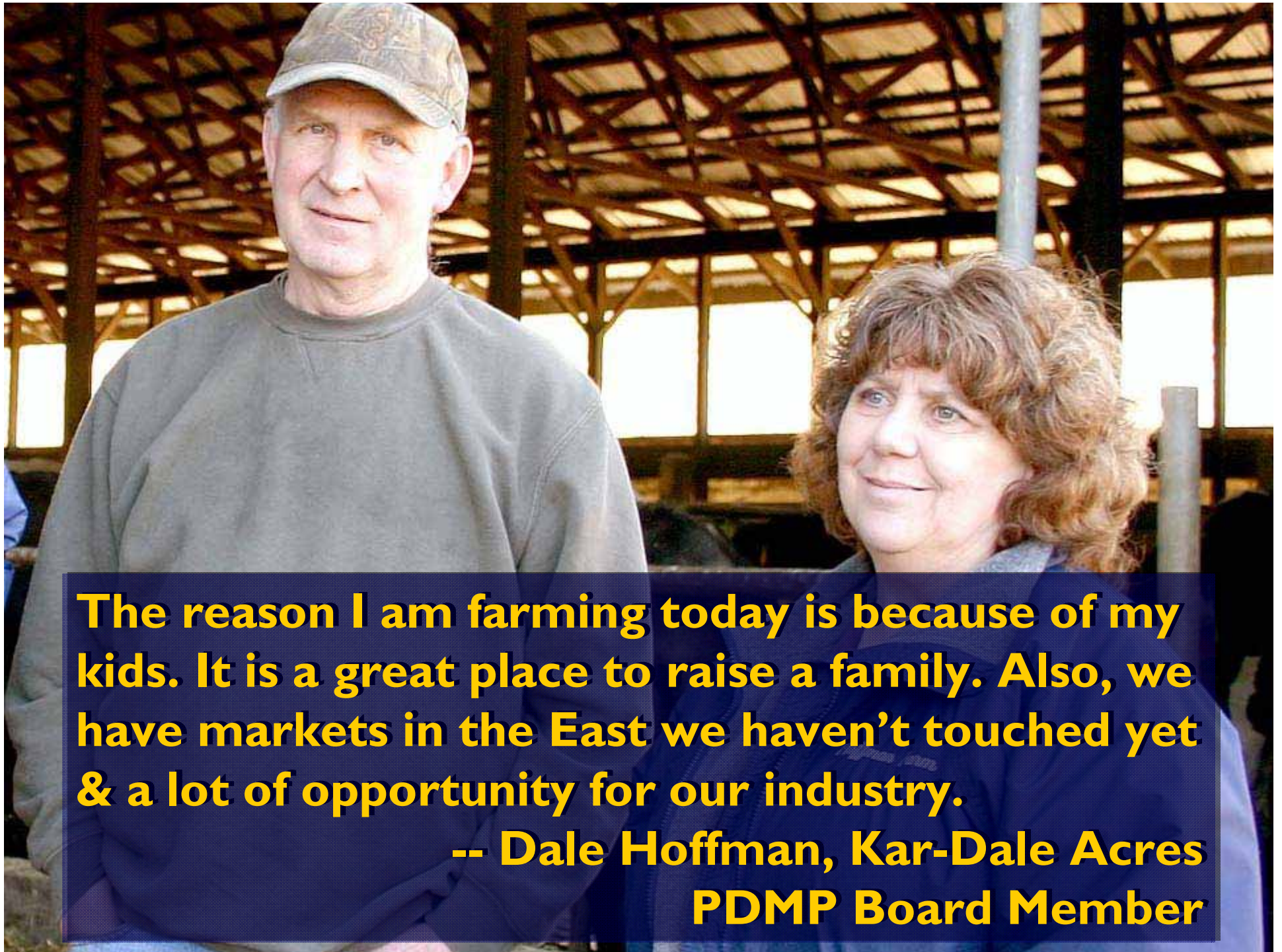
I have the honor of farming ground in a state that is full of history and has been farmed for many generations before me. I can take my place in that history and pass it on to the generations that will come after me.
