Funding Available for Young Producers to Attend Leadership Conference

Harrisburg, Pa. – The Center for Dairy Excellence Foundation of Pennsylvania and Pennsylvania Dairymen's Association are offering up to ten scholarships to Pennsylvania young dairy producers and other individuals interested in attending the PDPW Cornerstone Dairy Academy. The Cornerstone Academy focuses on the fundamentals of people-development skills, such as communication and leadership tools. Hosted by the Professional Dairy Producers of Wisconsin at Alliant Energy Center in Madison, WI., on March 13 and 14, 2018, the academy's program has been developed to meet the needs of today's dairy leaders across the country.
