- Western Pennsylvania The SpringHouse Washington, PA Saturday, October 16 from 6-8:30 p.m.

At each event, dairy producers and their families can enjoy:

- A free dinner
- Informal conversation families can stay for as little or as long as they would like
- Live music

- Resource-sharing from dairy industry organizations
- An overall atmosphere of positivity and encouragement

Producers can pre-register up to six people for the Dairy Appreciation Dinners. Multiple partners from the same farm can register separately. Based on interest and farm capacity at each location, the Center may close registration if needed.
