# **Youth Development:**

- ☆ Mary was accepted to speak once again at the National Association of Agriculture Educators Convention in Nashville, Tennessee during the week of December 4.
- A new Dairy Leaders of Tomorrow is slated to launch late this winter! Mary is working with Sharp Innovations to make the site more user-friendly and offer additional resources.
- ☆ The Fall Dairy Leaders of Tomorrow Farm Tour is scheduled for Friday, Oct. 13 in State College area. Students will be touring the PSU Dairy Barns, the PSU Creamer, visiting the PA Holstein Association and touring Paul Dotterer and Sons, Inc. All board members are invited to attend.
