September 'PROTECTING YOUR PROFITS' CALL TO BE HELD *Zepp to Review Market Fundamentals at Noon on September 27*

Harrisburg, Pa. – The Center for Dairy Excellence’s monthly “Protecting Your Profits” call will be held Wednesday, September 27, at noon. The call will be led by Alan Zepp, risk management program manager with the Center.

“Class III prices for all of the contracts for the next six months have fallen \$1.00 per hundredweight since the beginning of September,” Zepp said. “We will also discuss USDA’s recent announcement that dairy farmers may opt out of the Margin Protection Program.”

Cindy Walters from the Pennsylvania Farm Service Agency office will join the call to speak to these changes. Join the Center for Dairy Excellence for a twenty-minute discussion on dairy markets, margins and marketing plan alternatives.
